I. Competition goals and objectives

1. To develop the professionalism and musical taste of the young musician, revealing pedagogical principles of the famous violinist prof. Viktoras Radovičius
2. To expand the pedagogical repertoire of string players, including works of contemporary music.
3. To create favorable conditions for schoolchildren to play music, to develop their artistic taste and self-expression.
4. Develop stage experience and the joy of playing music.

II. Rules of the Competition

1. String players from children's music and art schools from Lithuania and other countries (except Russia and Belarus) are invited to participate in the competition.
2. Competition will be held in **December 10-11, 2022** at the Naujoji Vilnia Music School in Vilnius (Karklėnu st. 9, Vilnius).
3. Deadline to apply: **November 25, 2022**

Applicants must submit:

- Photo of the participant;
- Payment of the participation fee.

4. Categories:

I Category	Vocational education category, participating live
II Category	Vocational education category, participating remotely
III Category	Music Amateurs category, participating live
IV Category	Music Amateurs category, participating virtually

5. Age groups and duration of the program:

Age group	Program duration
A group 7 – 9 years old	Max. 10 minutes
B group 10 – 12 years old	Max. 15 minutes
C group 13 – 15 years old	Max. 25 minutes
D group 16 – 19 years old	Max. 30 minutes

6. Competition Program

6.1. Participants of the Music Amateurs and Vocational education categories must perform **2 (two)** musical pieces, one of which must be virtuosic;

6.2. All pieces must be performed by heart.

7. Participants participating **live**, must come to Vilnius Naujoji Vilnia Music School (Karklėnu st. 9, Vilnius) on the day of the event and register at the competition secretariat.

8. Participants participating **remotely**, when submitting an application online, provide a link to a high-quality video of the program on the YouTube platform:

8.1. both pieces can be recorded separately or together;

8.2. The video must be of high quality;

8.3. The video is uploaded to the YouTube platform:

- in the TITLE section, write "6th International V. Radovičius Competition for Young String Players";
- In the DESCRIPTION section, enter the participant's name and surname, country, competition program;
- Record's visibility is PUBLIC;
- By applying, participants agree that their entries will be placed in the public domain.

9. Participating fee:

9.1. For participants participating live – 30 EUR.

9.2. For participants participating remotely – 25 EUR.

9.3. The participating fee is non-refundable.
