I. Aims and objectives of the Festival – Competition

1. To honor Tauras Adomavičius, a professor of the LMTA, a long-term teacher of the Vilnius Naujoji Vilnia Music School, to encourage students to perform his works;
2. To give students the opportunity to perform live on stage;
3. To promote students' musicality, aesthetic taste, to reveal and develop professional skills in the performing art of young talents;
4. To encourage teachers of brass instruments to take an interest in the work of Lithuanian composers and to expand the repertoire of music schools;
5. To encourage teachers of music schools to cooperate, to develop methodological knowledge, pedagogical practice and subject competence.

II. Conditions of the Festival – Competition

1. Pupils of specialties of low brass wind instruments (**tenor, baritone, euphonium, trombone, tuba**) from various educational institutions in Lithuania and foreign countries are invited to participate in the competition.
2. Age groups of participants:

A group	(up to and including 9 years old)
B group	(from 10 to and including 12 years old)
C group	(from 13 to and including 15 years old)
D group	(from 16 to and including 18 years old)
3. Program of the Festival – Competition:

Each participant must perform 2 pieces by heart:

 1. A piece of Tauras Adomavičius*
 2. A free choice piece
