COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- Competition will take place in Vilnius, Naujoji Vilnia Music School (Karklėnų str. 9), 2022 October 22;
- Participants registration starts from 9 a. m.;
- Competition starts at 10 a.m.;
- The soloists and ensembles must perform 2-3 compositions of different styles by these age categories:

COMPETITION EVALUATION CRITERIA AND AWARDS

- Participants evaluation criteria are professionalism, musicality, program complexity, artistry;
- The performances of the participants will be evaluated by the competent Jury. Jury decisions are final and not subject to appeal;
- Jury members do not evaluate their students' performances;
- Participants of the Competition will be awarded with diplomas of winners, letters of graduates, souvenirs. The participant with the highest score will be awarded a GRAND PRIX and a cash prize.
